

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

You must inform us of travel arrangements to and from camp. Please complete and submit the **TRANSPORTATION ARRANGEMENTS Form at least 15 days prior to the start of camp.**

First day of *Land, Sea, Air, & Space* is Wednesday, July 1, 2026.

Last day of *Land, Sea, Air, & Space* is Friday, July 10, 2026.

First day of *Volcanoes in the Sea* is Saturday, July 11, 2026.

Last day of *Volcanoes in the Sea* is Monday, July 20, 2026.

NOTE ABOUT CELL PHONES: Camp policy does not allow campers to have their cell phones during camp; however, we strongly recommend that campers travel with their phones. Phones will be turned in after arrival at camp and will be returned prior to departure. Campers will have opportunities to use their phones from time to time during camp. Please see Camp Policies for details.

If traveling from Kauai, Oahu, Molokai, Lanai or Maui – FLY TO/FROM HILO

ARRIVAL: FIRST DAY: Make plans to arrive at the **Hilo** airport on the first day of camp between 1 pm and 4 pm. Camp staff will meet the flight, make sure all baggage is retrieved, and drive the arriving camper to camp.

DEPARTURE: LAST DAY: Departures from **Hilo** airport must be scheduled between 10 am and 2 pm. Camp staff will drive departing camper to the airport, ensure camper has their boarding pass and that baggage is checked, and wait with the camper until the camper has gone through the security gate.

If traveling from the mainland United States or Internationally – FLY TO/FROM HILO

ARRIVAL: Make plans to fly to the **Hilo** airport on the first day of camp between 1 pm and 4 pm. Camp staff will meet the flight, make sure all baggage is retrieved, and drive the arriving camper to camp.

If possible, arrange for a flight that flies directly from the mainland to Hilo. If not, you will have to change planes and possibly airlines in Honolulu or Maui. If changing planes in Honolulu, please try and keep layover times to less than two hours. We recommend *Hawaiian Airlines* as campers will usually be able to stay within the same area of the terminal. Note that there is only one terminal at Honolulu Airport – for all airlines, it will *not* be necessary to change terminals (with the exception of some commuter air flights).

DEPARTURE: LAST DAY: Departures from **Hilo** airport must be scheduled between 10 am and 1 pm. Camp staff will drive departing camper to the airport, ensure camper has their boarding pass and that baggage is checked, and wait with the camper until the camper has gone through the security gate.

IMPORTANT: We realize that the arrival and departure times listed may not always be possible depending on where the flights originate, and are prepared to be flexible to accommodate earlier or later flight arrival times. However, you must contact us prior to making your arrangements so we can verify that we will be able to meet or send off campers at the requested time.

If traveling from Hawaii Island

ARRIVAL: FIRST DAY: If driving your camper to camp, please plan to arrive between 3 and 4 pm. You must check in the arriving camper with camp staff prior to leaving. Alternately, you may meet our staff at a prescheduled time (between 1 pm and 4 pm) at the **Hilo** airport, sign in your camper with camp staff, and then camp staff will drive the arriving camper to camp.

DEPARTURE: LAST DAY: If picking up your camper at camp, it must be done before 11 am. Alternately, you may meet our staff at the **Hilo** airport at a prearranged time, make sure you have the camper's baggage and sign-out your camper with camp staff.

If staying for both sessions

Campers staying for both sessions may stay at camp between sessions. Campers will have supervision, stay in the cabins and be provided with meals between sessions; there will be no structured activities. There is no extra charge for these services.
